## Pupil Premium Grant 2016-17

Pupil Premium is additional funding to help schools close the gap between children from low income household and other disadvantaged circumstances and their peers. The funding is calculated by the number of children on the school roll registered for free school meals entitlement, looked after children or whose parents are serving in the armed forces.
