The National Curriculum in September 2014 made Languages compulsory in Key Stage 2.

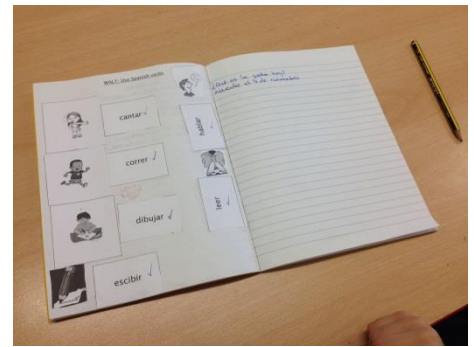
All children in the Junior school have an hour's Spanish lesson every two weeks.
