## EYFS Results

75% of pupils achieved a Good Level of Development (Prime Areas + Literacy and Maths) compared with 67% last year.

- This year 11 pupils took the resit. One of them had joined the school during Year 2 and one is in the ASC provision (leaving at the end of the year).
- Four of the group passed. Those who did not will continue to receive regular phonics support in a small group in the Junior School.

**Cohort Profile**

- 97 pupils (55 boys and 42 girls).
- 1 pupil has an EHC plan and is currently in the ASC provision (officially) disappplied from the data
- 9 other pupils are registered as SEND support on the school's register.
- 2 of these 10 pupils on the SEND register are also Pupil Premium.
- 26% of the cohort is eligible for Pupil Premium.
- 36% of the cohort is summer born.

**Key Stage 2 SATs Results**  
**July 2016**

**Cohort Profile**

- 119 pupils (59 boys and 60 girls).
- 2016 Raiseonline information states that this cohort entered the school -0.1 below the national average at the end of Key Stage 1. School evidence at the start of Year 3 indicates that the figure was lower than this, particularly in reading.
- The percentage of pupils joining the school as low attainers was 12% which is lower than the previous year (15%).
- 5 pupils have an EHC plan (1 attached to the Speech and Language provision) and 6 pupils are registered as SEND support on the school's register: Partially sighted, ASD, ADHD, learning difficulties and/or speech, language and communication needs.
- 6 of these 11 pupils are also Pupil Premium (slightly lower than last year).
- 40% of the cohort is eligible for Pupil Premium.
