

Bulletin Year 6 Spring Term 2017

Curriculum:

Science this term is based upon electricity and the human body. Our think link topic is an Ancient Civilisation as we are looking at the Mayas and their culture. We will study their growth and decline, daily life and role of the people.

Homework:

- Maths homework will be set on a Thursday and is due in the following Monday.
- English comprehension will be set on a Thursday and is due in the following Monday.
- Children may also be set specific writing or SPAG homework.
- Spellings will be set on a Monday and will be tested on the Friday.
- Reading journals will be checked by the class teacher every day, could you please sign your child's journal every day and make a comment on their reading.

Due to the importance of year six, we would expect an hour to be a good estimate of time for the English homework and half an hour for the Maths.
