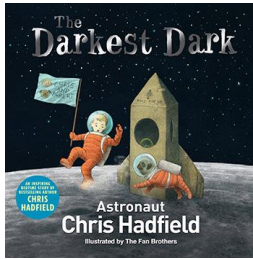


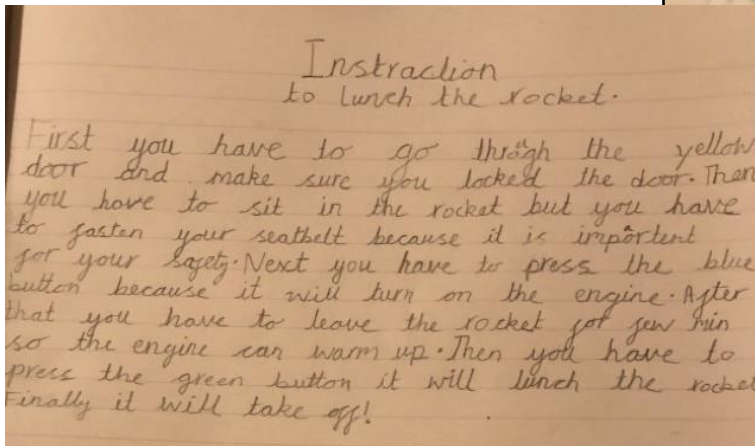

School to Parent Communications

We are pleased to see so many of our parents using our communication platform, Parent Hub. We hope you are all seeing the benefits, particularly whilst we manage these challenging times.

However, when we notice a parent has not accessed Parent Hub for some time we worry that important information is being missed. With this in mind, please ensure you always keep us informed if your mobile number changes, so that we can keep our records up to date. Parent Hub uses your mobile number and child's date of birth to link with our information system, to ensure the messages you receive are relevant to your child. Parent Hub abides by the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and their Privacy Policy can be accessed via *Help & Support* on their app.

Joining Instructions

- 1) Download the Parent Hub app from your app store (iPhone or Android)
- 2) Create an account
- 3) Choose 'Add a School' and enter the relevant school handle:
Infants: **@HeathfieldInf** Juniors: **@HeathfieldJun**
- 4) Select 'Add my Children'
- 5) Enter your mobile number. If it matches our records, you will be sent a pin code.
- 6) Enter the pin code
- 7) Enter your child's date of birth

Your account will then be linked with your child and you will automatically receive all the relevant messages. If you have children in both Infants and Juniors, you will need to add both schools.
