Year 1 Geography Trip

Year 1 have been learning about human and physical features in the environment as part of their geography topic. Last Friday each class went on a walking trip to record the features they saw. Liliana and Colby described the trip, *"First we went out of the school where the cars are. Then we went through the park and to the church. We wore a builder's suit so we could be seen. We had a clipboard with a piece of paper and little pictures on it. We had to tick the pictures if we found them: trees, a bus stop, a playground, a rubbish bin, a shop, a post box and a bench. It was a bit funny to do a rubbish bin because it was full of rubbish and smelly! We were worried about our legs hurting because it was a long trip but it was OK."*
