#### What We Have Been Doing

This week in <u>Nursery</u> we have been looking at shapes, going on a shape hunt around the Nursery and trying to identify features of the four main shapes which are circle, square, triangle and rectangle. Please continue to encourage your child to keep finding shapes in the environment. Now the children are developing their independence skills, we are so pleased to see the scooter park being very busy with



scooters and bikes. For those of you who are using a buggy to come to Nursery, please can we ask you to pack them away as compactly as possible. If your child has borrowed any clothing please can you return it to us as soon as possible. Alternatively we would welcome any donations of children's socks as we have very few pairs left.



This week in <u>Reception</u> we have continued reading the story of 'Big Cat' which sees a girl take in a tiger as a pet! This has created a lot of discussions as to the pets we have, would like or not like! We have been consolidating our clever counting to 10 as well as practising reading all of the numbers from 1-10. A gentle reminder, please send in your consent forms and money for our trip to Windsor

Castle as soon as possible. Next Thursday, 24th October we will be having our first open morning for current Reception parents from 9.15am until 10.00am. Come along and join in some art and crafts and see what your child enjoys doing inside and outside the classroom.





This week <u>Year 1</u> finished reading the book 'Grendel'. The children sequenced the pictures from the story and retold it in their own words. As part of our history topic, Toys Through

Time, we have studied Andy Warhol and his pop art pieces. We produced our own versions using images of teddy bears. We used wax crayons and watercolours to create our art work and have also been finding out about how Diwali is celebrated in our community. We created firework pictures, rangoli patterns, Rama and Sita puppets and designed our own mehndi hand patterns. We also learnt a special Diwali song!



<u>Year 2</u> had a fantastic week in English where they have worked hard predicting what they think will happen in their next text, Zeraffa Giraffa. We planned out what the story might be about and even wrote our own stories based on our predictions. We then began to look at a giraffe's habitat and thought carefully about what a giraffe needs to live and created our own habitats. In maths we have been adding using the partitioning method and then applied this knowledge to word problems. All the children had a fantastic time learning how to ride their scooters safely and will be receiving their certificates to reflect this. In P.E the children began to understand the term 'relay' and practiced their running skills. As a reminder, the children will be visiting Wagamamas next week.
