## SATs Results

We are delighted to let you know that our Year 2 and Year 6 children performed excellently in their SATs last term. Our provisional results show that in all areas, more of our children achieved the expected standard compared to the Year 2 and Year 6 population nationally. For example 81% of our Year 6 children reached the expected standard in maths, compared to 71% nationally. A further breakdown of these results will be available on our website shortly. We are particularly pleased with all these results in light of the unsettled time we have experienced over the past few years with the Covid pandemic.
