## School Streets - Monday 16th September

Following the consultation last year, the Council have decided to launch two School Streets starting next Monday 16th September. School Streets are designed to promote safer roads around schools, encourage active travel (walking or cycling to and from school) and reduce children's exposure to pollution by reducing the number of vehicles around the school at the start and end of the day.

Signs will be put in place shortly. The first three restrictions below will apply from Monday to Friday, 7.45-9.30am and 2.30-3.45pm (term time only), the other changes will apply at all times:

- 1) Cobbett Road and Longford Road will become School Streets.
- 2) Cobbett Road is accessible to exempt vehicles only (such as residents and blue badge holders).
- 3) Only exempt vehicles may enter Longford Road from Powder Mill Lane.
- 4) All vehicles may exit from Longford Road onto Powder Mill Lane at any time.
- 5) Longford Road will be one-way entry from Hospital Bridge Road at all times.
- 6) Springfield Road will be no entry from Hospital Bridge Road at all times.
