During Autumn One, Year 3 are learning about the Stone Age. As part of this, the children will be taking part in a Stone Age Workshop in school on **Tuesday 9th October**.

The workshop will be run by **Portal to the Past** and will provide the children with the opportunity to think about the question - “**who are we and where do we come from?**”

The timeless questions, and more, will be addressed as the children are given the opportunity to explore many of the important developments that helped to make us who we are, from the original hunter gatherers to early farming communities, ancient technology and coming of the age of metal.

The Portal to the Past workshop leaders are trained bush-craft experts and have a detailed understanding of ancient technology and how is still used by some societies around the world today. The session consists of group investigation, where students explore numerous informative displays and artefacts and get hands-on experience of ancient technology and skills.
