English

This term in English we continue to read Street Child before moving on to read Clockwork by Philip Pullman – gripping, short novel that we will use to help the children write in a range of genres as well as completing close reading and reading comprehension lessons based on these texts.

Maths

In maths we will be doing our summer revision block of all areas of the KS2 National curriculum to fully prepare the children for SATs week.

Science

In Summer 1 we will be covering Evolution including how animals and plants adapt to suit their environment. In Summer 2 we will complete the Relationship and Sex Education unit.

Humanities

In Summer 1 and 2 we will continue with Geography. The focus will be on Human geography looking at settlements, and thinking about why people choose to live in certain places. We will then move on to look at the weather and climate and how these can effect humans. Finally, the child will be doing a fieldwork unit at the end of the year based on how the school could improve its Carbon Footprint.
