This term our workshops and visitors are linked to our history topic of World War 2, RSE and our RE topic of Humanism.

- Boundless dance group will visit us and help us to choreograph our own WW2 swing dance – Wednesday 31st January
- Theatre Exchange will also be visiting us to workshop an evacuee drama, thinking about how it would feel to be a child sent away from the cities during the Blitz – Thursday 21st March
- We will have a virtual visit from the National Archives at Kew to look at and discuss the type of propaganda posters during the war. We will also think about how they were used in the fight against the Axis various dates in February
- A visit from the Humanist Society to deliver a lesson all about Humanism date to be confirmed
- A visit from the Royal National Lifeboat Institution Friday 1st March
- Feelings Workshop Wednesday 13th March
