On Wednesday, 3rd April, Reception will be holding an Open Morning from 9.15am until 10.15am. Please come and spend some time with your child in their classrooms and enjoy some of the Easter activities we have planned.

In English, Year 1 learnt all about the deep sea ocean as we continued our journey through 'One Night, Far from Here'. We talked about the three zones in the ocean, Sunlight, Twilight and Moonlight, and wrote some fantastic action poems about jellyfish. In maths we are learning about grouping objects into equal and unequal groups. We used counters to make

different groups and found out that there were lots of different ways to group them. Children have also been counting in 2's, 5's and 10's when adding groups.

This week in Year 2 we have really enjoyed becoming statisticians. We have been collecting data and can now use tally charts, pictograms and block charts. If you have time this weekend maybe you could collect data on something like the colours of cars or toys in your house. In English we have



continued with the modern version of Rapunzel and wrote a character description of the wicked witch and have enjoyed writing instructions for Rapunzel to escape the tower! Are there any instructions in your house? Finally it has been lovely to hear about the kind of helpful things children have done at home. Please keep sending them in so we can add more leaves to our Kindness Tree.
