ParentHub App – Please ensure you have this app active on your phone. It is free for you to download and easy to set up. To join this school, you need to enter the 'handle' **@HeathfieldJun**. Once you enter your mobile number, it links with your child's details so that you get notifications from us relating to your child's year group. If you have any difficulties with this please see a member of the office team for assistance.



Scopay Emails – This is accessed via the internet. Please ensure you have subscribed to receive emails, as we have noticed some parents have unsubscribed. You will only receive emails relevant to your child at school. If you are unsure whether you have unsubscribed, please log in to your Scopay account and scroll down to the bottom. If, in small print, you see the word *Resubscribe*, you must click on this word to start receiving emails again.

Goal Setting Assembly

On Thursday 9th January we welcomed three former Great British athletes as they delivered a fantastic assembly on goal setting. Tony Jarrett, Kate Staples and Jonathan Barbour talked about their sporting journeys and their experiences of competing at the very highest level. Jonathan has competed at two World Athletics Championships and an Olympics in the 4x100m relay.



Kate was a pole vaulter and the very first British female to jump over 3 metres. She has broken the British record over 40 times. She competed at the Commonwealth Games at Kuala Lumpur.

Tony is England's fastest ever 110m hurdler. He has won numerous medals including three silver and two bronze medals at three World Championships.
