Hanworth Junior Parkrun is a FREE 2km event for junior runners (4-14 years old) of all standards and takes place every Sunday at 9am in Hanworth Air Park Leisure Centre & Library, Uxbridge Road, TW13 5EG.





As a school we have supported this great event for the last few years and our school is often the most represented there. This year we are encouraging children to attend by offering a house point for every week they run from the Sunday 10th October until Sunday 7th November. Then on Sunday 14th November, we are running a trip from school to the event with several teachers joining the children on the 2k run. Children will also receive certificates for attending.
