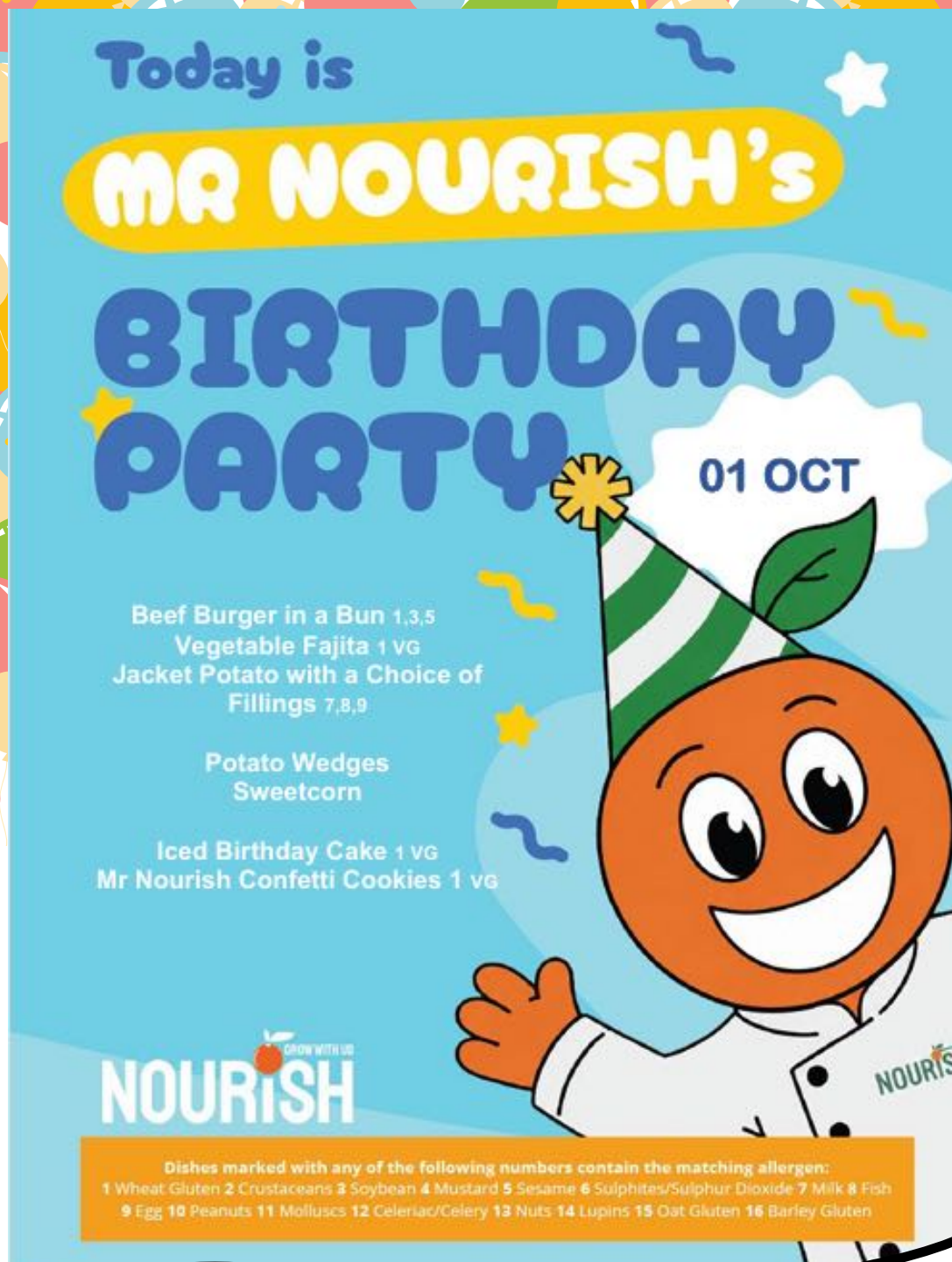


## NURSERY AND RECEPTION
