CURRICULUM OVERVIEW – SPANISH

Intent

The languages curriculum will ensure that children will be able to:

- Understand and respond to speakers of Spanish.
- Speak Spanish with increased confidence and fluency.
- Express their ideas and thoughts in Spanish.
- Appreciate the Spanish culture.

Implementation

The schools' languages progression document outlines the knowledge and skills that will be covered in each year group.

EYFS and Key Stage 1

Children in EYFS and Key Stage 1 explore a variety of languages through the broad curriculum.

Key Stage 2

By 2021 it is our aim that each year group has one hour of Spanish a week on a rolling programme.

We are currently looking into a Spanish scheme to deliver quality Spanish lessons.

Current practice teaches the skills outlined in the Spanish progression document.

Displays are used to remind children of key vocabulary.

Practical activities: songs and games are used to help improve memory and recall.

Impact

Assessment

In Key Stage 2 assessment during lessons enables the teacher to adapt planning as required. Key questions on the planning support these assessment techniques.

Monitoring

Members of the Senior Strategy Team and Year Group Leaders undertake a range of monitoring activities across a year that include:

- "Pop ins"/learning walks
- Discussions with children

An in-depth review of Spanish takes place every 2 years as outlined on the schools' review schedule.
