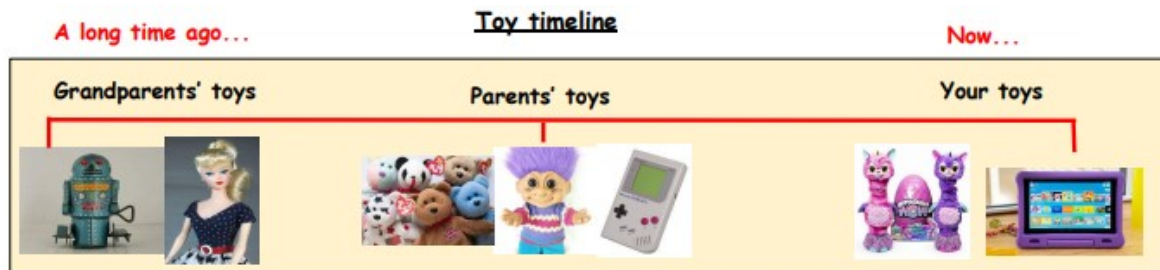

Toys are objects that we play with. They can be old or new and made from different materials. Children have always played with toys. We will investigate photos and objects to work out what toys are made from and how this might help us to work out if a toy is old or new:

Key knowledge



Toys in the past were often made from **wood**, **metal** and **fabric**.



Toys in the past used clockwork or wind up.



Toys from the past had a different style and may look 'old fashioned'.



Newer toys are often made from **plastic**.



Newer toys often use batteries or electronics.



Newer toys are often based on TV or films.

We will also be learning about how the teddy bear has changed over time. The teddy bear was named after an American president, Teddy Roosevelt. The first teddy bears were made in America in 1902 and in Germany in 1903. The two makers didn't know that they were each making teddy bears because they lived so far apart. Teddy bears now come in lots of different shapes and sizes and are often based on popular characters.
