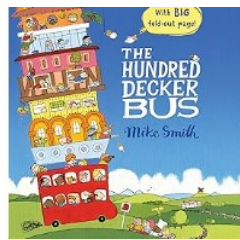

Miss English

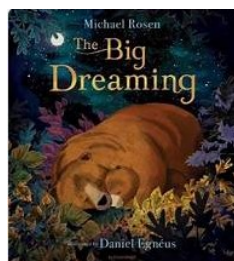

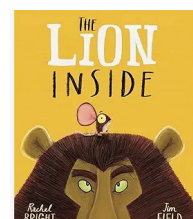

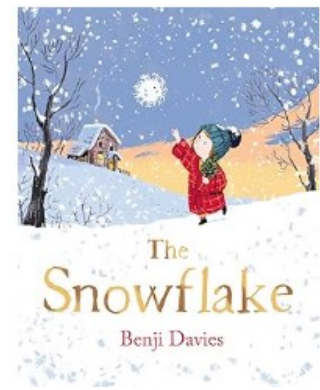

## The snowflake

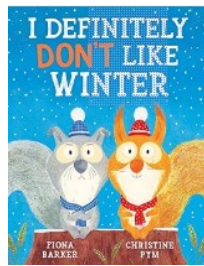
By Benji Davies.

## I definitely don't like Winter

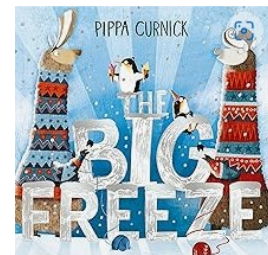

## The big freeze

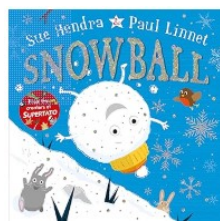

## Snowball

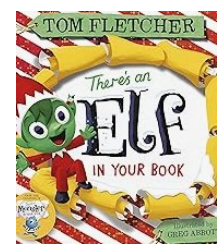
