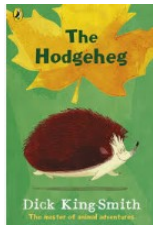

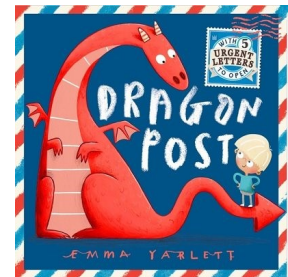


Miss de Garston-Webb
