<u>English</u>

This term in English we continue to read Street Child allowing the children to write in a range of genres such as an explanation text, narrative, letter, persuasive argument, recount and discussion as well as completing close reading and reading comprehension lessons based on these texts.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths we will be doing our summer revision block of all areas of the KS2 National curriculum. We recommend using the following site which has lots of revision activities: https://uk.ixl.com/maths/year-6

<u>Homework</u>

- Maths homework will be set on a Monday and is due in on the Friday of the same week.
- English homework will be set on a Monday and is due in on the Friday of the same week.
- Spellings will be set on a Friday and will be tested on the following Friday.
- Reading journals will be checked by the class teacher every day, could you please sign your child's journal every day and make a comment on their reading.

Due to the importance of year six, we would expect an hour to be a good estimate of time for the Non-Core homework and half an hour for the Maths.

A homework club will run every lunchtime during the week and all children are encouraged to attend.

<u>Science</u>

In Summer 1 we will be covering Evolution including how animals and plants adapt to suit their environment. In Summer 2 we will complete the Relationship and Sex Education unit.

<u>Humanities</u>

In Summer 1 and 2 we will continue with Geography. The focus will be on Human geography looking at settlements, and thinking about why people choose to live in certain places. We will then move on to look at the weather and climate and how these can effect humans. Finally, the child will be doing a fieldwork unit at the end of the year based on how the school could improve its Carbon Footprint.

PE/Games

All children will be expected to have their kit in school all week. For PE they will need a house Tshirt and black shorts. For games they will need appropriate clothing to go outside: tracksuit, sweatshirts and trainers.
