## The Heathfield Way

When children follow, 'The Heathfield Way' they will be awarded house points, which are recorded in their reading diary.

#### English

This term in English we continue to read Street Child allowing the children to write in a range of genres such as an explanation text, narrative, letter, persuasive argument, recount and discussion as well as completing close reading and reading comprehension lessons based on these texts. We will then move on to Clockwork by Philip Pullman.

#### **Maths**

This term the children will learning about shape, ratio and algebra. We will complete an arithmetic or a reasoning test every Friday. We will also be doing our summer revision block of all areas of the KS2 National curriculum. ## **Reading Diary**

Reading and books are a huge part of our life at Heathfield and all children will go home every day with a carefully matched reading book for their step level. In Year 6 children are expected to read aloud to an adult or independently daily for about **30 minutes** every night, including weekends. After they have read, the children need to record the title of the book and comment about what they have read in their reading diary each day. An adult from home should then sign next to the comment. Your child's teacher will then read your child's comment and sign the reading diary too.

We understand that sometimes children find it hard to write a comment about what they have read so here are some ideas about what they might write about:

- What has happened in the book so far?
- Who is their favourite character and why?
- Words or phrases they particularly liked or wanted to investigate

What they predict is going to happen next?

# **Science**

In Summer 1 we will be covering Evolution including how animals and plants adapt to suit their environment. In Summer 2 we will complete the Relationship and Sex Education unit.

## **Humanities**

In Summer 1 and 2 we will be studying Geography. We will look at the weather and climate and how these can effect humans. Finally, the child will be doing a fieldwork unit at the end of the year based on how the school could improve its Carbon Footprint and CO2 levels in our local area.

# Homework

- Maths homework will be set on a Monday and will be due in on the Friday of the same week and will be set by your child's maths set teacher.
- Non-core homework will be set a Monday and will be due in on the Friday of the same week. There will be a homework club run which will run during lunchtimes on various days of the week.
- Spelling homework will be set on a Friday and due in the following Friday.

#### PΕ

Please ensure that your child has full PE kit in school every day. This includes black shorts or jogging bottoms, a T-shirt in team colours and trainers.

- Mandela Class PE lessons are on Tuesday and Thursday
- Carroll Class- PE lessons are on Friday and Thursday

- Ortelius Class- PE lessons are on Wednesday and Thursday
