- To give reasons for a choice using 'porque'
- To ask and understand simple questions
- To hold a short conversation
- To identify some Spanish verbs and be familiar with the imperative.
- To use the present tense to say what I am doing
- To name key places in a town.



Activities we will complete

Children will complete a variety of spoken, physical and written activities to develop their knowledge, pronunciation and language skills. These will include:

- Role play tasks
- Learning and performing songs and rhymes
- Playing language games
- Worksheet based tasks
- Simple reading and writing tasks

Key Vocabulary and sounds

- Silent 'h' in 'hola'
- 'th' or 's' sound in 'la estacion'
- Ñ sound in 'España' (tilde changes the 'n' sound to 'ny').
- Rr sound in 'los Churros'
- Ll sound in 'me llamo'
