

Our music teaching is taught through a program of study created by the company Charanga. Lessons are taught by class teachers and provide children with the opportunity to develop their understanding of musical theory, improve their performing skills with activities focused on listening and musical appreciation.

A weekly singing assembly supports this work and is used by the school's choir leader to improve the whole school's singing performance. Children learn a range of traditional and popular songs.

Wider Opportunities

As part of the national scheme run by the Richmond Music Trust children in Year 4 take part in two terms of free music tuition. In the Autumn this focuses on vocal work and in the Spring lessons provide an introduction to guitar teaching.

After this children have the chance to continue with paid guitar lessons.



Music Tuition

Children have the chance to take part in a wide range of specialist music tuition including drumming, guitar and singing.

'Rocksteady' a music school company provide a different opportunity for children to learn an instrument within a band and perform their choice of songs.

Our Federated choir is open to children from Years 2-6. The choir take part in the annual singing festival as well as performing at other events throughout the year.

New developments this year

We now have a specialist music teacher working across the schools. Mr Speck provides singing lessons in small groups and has supported teachers in the development of their music teaching by demonstrating model lessons. His expertise has really enhanced the music provision in the school this year.
