

Bulletin Year 6 Spring Term 2020

Curriculum:

Science this term is based upon electricity and the human body. Our think link topic is an Ancient Civilisation as we are looking at the Mayans and their culture. We will study their growth and decline, daily life and role of the people.

Homework:

- Maths homework will be set on a Monday and is due in on the Friday of the same week.
- English homework will be set on a Monday and is due in on the Friday of the same week
- Children may also be set specific writing or SPAG homework.
- Spellings will be set on a Friday and will be tested on the following Friday.
- Reading journals will be checked by the class teacher every day, could you please sign your child's journal every day and make a comment on their reading.

Due to the importance of year six, we would expect an hour to be a good estimate of time for the English homework and half an hour for the Maths.

A homework club will run every lunchtime during the week and all children are encouraged to attend.

PE/Games:

Year 6 outdoor games: Wednesday and Thursday for all classes. All children will be expected to have their kit in school all week. For PE they will need a house colour T-shirt and black shorts. For games they will need appropriate clothing to go outside: tracksuit, sweatshirts, trainers.
